Dear Friend:

May the Almighty God do great things in your life in these troubled times.

Greetings in the Name of Jesus from the bloody land of Mexico.

I am sure you have heard the news reports from Mexico:

- · Killings every day
- a terrible economical crisis
- 1st in the world for kidnapping (Iraq is #2)
- 2nd in the world for killing journalists (Iraq is #1)

All this is next door to the USA.

But we also have good news: This turmoil causes people to see life soberly and to seek answers. And we are taking full advantage of this opportunity. Amen.

We have had a very busy summer holding 8 tent campaigns and visiting prisons. In the prisons we celebrated 9 baptisms. We have ministered in a variety of ways and it is not over yet.

We just started a 40 day campaign under our tent a few days ago. For the 6th

year in a row we are camped in the middle of people who are destitute and hopeless. They are alcoholics, drug addicts, and violent young men. These people come during the Apple harvest looking for work.

Many of these people are teenagers. Drug addicts will use varnish, thinner, glue, and loads of marijuana to escape their lives. Alcoholics will drink 90% alcohol which is not only cheap here but deadly. I am not exaggerating to say these men, women, and children are the slaves of this century.

Hundreds of children came to our "summer school" (or VBS) that we held in different towns. We had a wonderful team of coworkers that were a blessing to the children and to us. It was the best VBS we've had in the last 6 years.

We had disciples from Colorado, Texas, and different parts of Mexico. To all of these brothers & sisters goes the gratitude of our hearts.

We want you to know that we are praying for the political election in the USA of this coming November. How can some Christians

be so blind or careless regarding the human tragedy?

Let me close with the following statement: "The most selfish person in all the world is a Christian who wants to go to heaven alone".

Do all you can for the glory of God, my brother, in the way He showed you. Do it with all your heart for the night is coming.
