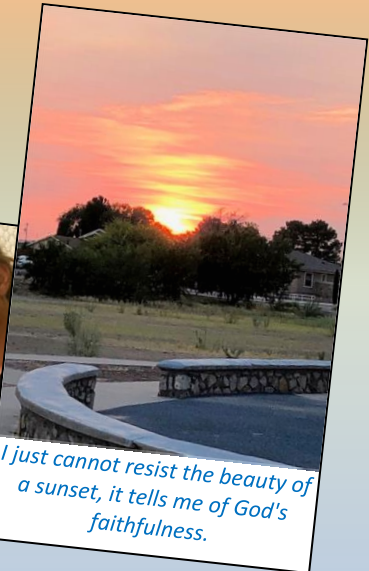
Coming back from a shopping center, Wendy told me about a super sale of back pack, from 10 to 2 dls. We purchase 200 , to bless 200 needed students.
